DRIVEWAY BLADE AGREEMENT

The Leavenworth Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) has authorized the use of one (1) hour of motor grader time per family per year under the Policy on Local Service Roads. This service will be provided by the Leavenworth County Shop under the following mutually agreed upon conditions:

1. This time is available in a one-hour block only one time per year only. There will be no splitting of this time over multiple periods.
2. This time is only available under parcels that are subject to the Local Service Road and Bridge mil levee (basically the unincorporated part of the county).
3. This work shall apply to the shaping of a driveway by a motor grader only as specifically identified in the Policy, all other requests for additional work or other equipment is prohibited
4. The timing of this work is subject to the eligibility of County Shop workforce, and will be incorporated into the routine gravel road maintenance schedule when available. The use of this policy for snow or debris removal is specifically prohibited.
5. Leavenworth County is prohibited from providing additional rock to individual owners.

Under this agreement property owners understand the risk of operating heavy equipment on private property and will release Leavenworth County from any damages that may be incidental to their request.

1. Leavenworth County responsibility ends at the edge of the Right of Way. All of this work is on private property and the owner assumes that responsibility.
2. Any obstructions (fence posts, gates, buildings, vegetation, etc...) must be identified and protected by the owners.
3. Any damage to unseen obstructions (septic tanks, utilities, irrigation systems, etc...) shall be the responsibility of the property owners.
4. Owner placed rock must be sufficiently spread to allow for efficient and effective use of the grader (LVCO will not spread from a dumped stockpile)
5. Property Owner grants permission for Leavenworth County to access private property to perform this service.

Each request shall be considered individually, and will be evaluated by County Shop personnel. Any considerations that are site specific or unique should be written below:
