
Review Staff:

The Leavenworth County Public Works Department has scheduled the construction of improvements to 207th Street in rural Leavenworth County, Kansas for the 2015 construction season. The project runs from the center of Section 3 – Township 9 South – Range 21 East to the South 1/4 corner of Section 10 – Township 9 South – Range 21 East, and will construct geometric, drainage, and surface improvements to approximately 1.5 mi. of the existing alignment of 207th Street. No alterations to existing water courses are planned. Erosion control and stormwater pollution prevention measures will be installed in accordance with the engineered plan set. The following items have been enclosed with this cover letter for your reference:

1. One original signed-dated NOI Permit Application Form.
2. Topographic Area Map.
3. Construction Plan Set to include Erosion Control Detail Sheets.
4. Written description of best management practices.
5. Summary of sequence of major soil disturbing activities and the corresponding erosion control measures.
6. *Note:* The KSHS and the KDWPT have both been contacted with respect to this project. Copies of the appropriate documents are enclosed. All correspondence granting approval will be forwarded to KDHE immediately upon receipt.
7. A check in the amount of \$60.00 for the initial annual permit fee.

NOTICE OF INTENT (NOI)

For Authorization to Discharge Stormwater Runoff from Construction Activities
 In accordance with the Kansas Water Pollution Control General Permit
 Under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES)

Submission of this Notice of Intent constitutes notice that the party identified in Section I of this form requests authorization for coverage under the Kansas Water Pollution Control general permit, or KDHE issued successor permits, issued for stormwater runoff from construction activities in the State of Kansas. Becoming a permittee obligates the discharger to comply with the terms and conditions of the general permit. **Completion of this NOI does not provide automatic coverage under the general permit. Coverage is provided and discharge permitted when the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) authorizes the discharge of stormwater runoff from the construction activities identified on the NOI and supporting documentation. A signed and dated copy of the first page of the NOI indicating the Authorization will be provided to the owner or operator, or all three pages for Conditional Authorizations.** Upon authorization of the construction activity discharge, a Kansas permit number and a Federal permit number will be assigned to the construction project. **A complete request for Authorization for coverage under the general permit must be submitted or the request will not be processed (see listing on Page 3 of this NOI).** KDHE will notify owners or operators whose Notice of Intent (NOI) and supporting documentation for Authorization of stormwater runoff associated with construction activities are incomplete, deficient, or denied.





FIGURE F. Area Map – South Half of Project

Erosion Control Implementation

1. Install straw bale ditch checks in accordance with plan sheets.
2. Install biologs and/or silt fence in accordance with plan sheets.
3. Install straw bale barriers at cross-road culvert inflow locations.
4. Inspect condition of erosion control measures every week, and after each precipitation event equal to or exceeding 0.50-inches.
5. Place riprap at outflow end of all cross-road culverts in accordance with plan sheets.
6. Place aggregate ditch liner as noted on plan sheets.
7. Seed and mulch all disturbed areas.
8. Silt fence will be removed after adequate vegetation has been established. Biologs to remain in place.

Construction Sequence Summary

1. Install straw bale barriers at all cross-road culvert inflow locations.
2. Commence with site grading to construct design road geometry.
3. Install straw bale ditch checks and biolog / silt fence slope barriers immediately upon completion of ditch and ditch foreslope / backslope construction.
4. Finalize site grading – place riprap at cross-road culvert outflow locations, and place aggregate ditch liner.
5. Construct new 166th Street chip-seal wearing surface.
6. Seed and mulch all disturbed areas.
7. Straw bale barriers and ditch checks to remain in place.
8. Inspect the project site one year after completion. Seed and mulch bare areas as needed.
9. Silt fence to be removed after adequate vegetation has been established. Biologs to remain in place.
