Dear Leavenworth County Landowner:

This letter has been prepared to provide you with an update on the current status of the above-referenced County project.

*147<sup>th</sup> Street from Hollingsworth Road to Donahoo Road.* Affidavits for easement dedication were received from all affected landowners on December 4, 2012. Thank you for your participation up to this point in time. For the next phase of this project, Leavenworth County personnel will finalize land survey operations, and prepare engineered construction plans. These items are expected to be complete within the next couple of months.

In my prior update letter, dated January 4, 2013, a *tentative* construction year of 2014 was provided. I regret to inform you that construction of surface, geometric, and drainage improvements will not occur during the 2014 calendar year. Various aspects of the project have proven to be more complex and time consuming than anticipated. As you might be aware, the east half of the project lies within the city limits of Basehor; additionally, a prior inter-local agreement with the City of Basehor must be given proper consideration. Leavenworth County intends to continue discussions with the City of Basehor to resolve these, and other, issues. It will not be possible to establish a revised schedule until an agreement is reached between Basehor and Leavenworth County. Please know that this project will move back to the forefront of Leavenworth County road improvement projects once a signed agreement is executed with the City of Basehor.

Periodic updates will be sent in the future to keep you informed as to the status of this project. If you have any questions or comments, please feel free to contact me.
