Re: **Leavenworth County Participatory Road Program**

Dear Leavenworth County Landowner:

This letter has been prepared to provide you with an update on the current status of the above-referenced County project candidate.

*178<sup>th</sup> Street from Evans Road to Kansas Avenue.* Affidavits for easement dedication were recently received from all affected landowners. Thank you for your participation up to this point. This project has been added to the *Participatory Road Program* project candidate queue. For the next phase of this project, Leavenworth County personnel will commence with land survey operations, and the subsequent preparation of engineered construction plans after these activities have been completed for prior scheduled projects. Currently, there are four (4) other projects that have been scheduled ahead of yours.

As a good-faith gesture on behalf of Leavenworth County for your 100% signed-affidavit participation, the Board of County Commissioners has agreed to pay for temporary *chemical* dust control on your segment of road for the 2015 summer months. In the near future, you will likely see County forces constructing preparations to 178<sup>th</sup> Street prior to application of liquid magnesium-chloride solution by a private contractor. This *chemical* dust treatment is typically fairly effective through the summer and fall seasons, but is destroyed in the winter months during snow removal operations.

If this project is ultimately constructed, proposed future road upgrades for this segment of road under the Participatory Road Program would consist of geometric improvements, surface improvements, and drainage improvements.

Updates will be sent in the future, as new information becomes available, to keep you informed as to the status of this project.
