


147th Street between Fairmount (CR#8) and State Ave (US24/40)



Project Data:

Section: Arterial/Collector (32' to 40' roadway)
 Length: 4.0 miles
 Surface: Asphalt (Standard Truck Capacity)

Roadway

Phase 1 (Design): \$600k
 Phase 2 (ROW): \$500k
 Phase 3 (Utility): \$300k
 Phase 4 (Construction): \$12M

Bridge F-19 (20' Span)

Project Cost : \$500k – 700k

Project Est.: \$10M-\$15M (2012 dollars)

This project would be jointly undertaken between Leavenworth County and the City of Basehor. It is consistent with the K-7 corridor plan, which forecasts development within 1-mile each side of the highway. It provides for another alternate route that could see significant development .

Other Considerations: There is an interlocal agreement in place for 147th between Hollingsworth and Donahoo. This project could also be phased in mile segments as development occurs. Additionally, the section between Parallel and State Avenue does not exist, nor does the access to US24/40. Basehor would be responsible for the creation of new roadway between Parallel and State, as well as granting of access by KDOT.

The Basehor Mayor approached LVCO staff with this project in August of 2012, but no formal action of their City Council has resulted.
