


McIntyre Road between US-3/K-7 and K-5



Project Data:

Section: Arterial/Collector (32' to 40' roadway)
Length: 2.0 miles
Surface: Asphalt (Standard Truck Capacity)

Roadway Project

Phase 1 (Design):	\$300k
Phase 2 (ROW):	\$200k
Phase 3 (Utility):	\$200k
Phase 4 (Construction):	\$4.5M
Project Estimate:	\$5M-\$7M (2012 dollars)

This project would be jointly undertaken between Leavenworth County and the City of Lansing. It would provide connectivity between the K-7 expressway and Kansas Highway 5 into KCK and onto I-435. This improvement would be a permanent link that will allow for further development to the southeast part of Lansing, and far eastern Leavenworth County.

Other Considerations: The project should be executed along with the City of Lansing through an interlocal agreement to outline each party's responsibilities. Details of the design may be undertaken in accordance with the Lansing City Specifications providing an avenue for future annexation and expansion by the city.

Future K-5 realignment under a statewide transportation bill would not be hampered by this project
