A RESOLUTION OF THE BOAR OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LEAVENWORTH COUNTY, KANSAS, ADOPTING A MULTI-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN ON A PRIORITIZED BASIS; AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FUND AS PROVIDED FOR BY K.S.A. 19-120.

WHEREAS the board of county commissioners has conducted a study of the public improvements needs of the county; and

WHEREAS addressing the identified public improvement needs of the county will require a multi-year commitment to those needs; and

WHEREAS the board of county commissioners is authorized to approve a multi-year capital improvements plan on a prioritized basis; and

WHEREAS K.S.A. 19-120 authorizes the establishment of a capital improvements fund upon the approval of a multi-year capital improvements plan on a prioritized basis,

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED

1. That the multi-year capital improvements plan set forth in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and fully incorporated herein, is hereby approved and adopted by the board.
2. That there is hereby established a capital improvements fund for the county, said fund to be utilized to finance those capital improvements needs of the county as set forth in the multi-year capital improvements plans as approved and adopted.
3. That the capital improvements fund established herein may be used for engineering and other advance public improvements plans and studies and that reimbursements may be made to the fund from bond proceeds, special assessments or state or federal aid available for any completed project.



